Inaugurates 11 godowns in PACS in as many states

PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA Modi on Saturday launched the world's largest grain storage plan in the cooperative sector, entailing an investment of over ₹1.25 trillion, with the inauguration of 11 godowns in primary agricultural credit societies (PACS) in as many states.

thousands of warehouses and godowns will be constructed across the country," he said after inaugurating 11 godowns set up by 11 PACS across 11 states. He rued that farmers were forced to bear huge losses due to lack of storage infrastructure in the country, "Previous governments never paid due attention to this problem. But today through PACS, this problem is being addressed. Under the world's largest food grain storage programme, 70 million tonne storage capacity will be created in the next five years. On

this initiative more than ₹1.25 trillion will be spent," the prime minister said. With the creation of the huge storage facilities, Modi said farmers would be able to store their produce in the godowns/warehouses, get institutional credit against it, and sell their items when market prices are remunerative. He also asked cooperative organisations to work towards reducing imports of food items, including edible oils and pulses, and also fertilisers. Modi also emphasised on the importance of bringing transparency in the

"Absolutely captivating chat with @dkhos, CEO of @Uber. His vision for Uber's expansion in India is truly inspiring, especially his commitment to uplifting Indian drivers and their dignity. Excited for future collaborations with Dara and his team! #UberIndia," Adani said in a post on X.

The Uber CEO said he met the head of ports-to-energy conglomerate over breakfast for an "absolutely terrific conversation". He also highlighted the mobility service provider's commitment to accelerate EV transition in India. Adani also posted pictures of the meeting but the two did not say where the meeting took place. The pictures seem to suggest the meeting took

place at Adani group's headquarters in Ahmedabad. "An absolutely terrific conversation with @gautam\_adani over a delicious breakfast about India's phenomenal growth and rising entrepreneurship. @Uber is committed to scaling up shared mobility and accelerating transition to EVs — looking forward to take our partnership to the next level," Dara replied to Adani's post. The Uber CEO arrived in

India earlier this week. During this time, the ride-sharing platform Uber on February 22 signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Open Network for Digital Commerce (ONDC) to explore an integration with the network to expand the range of mobility offerings on the Uber app. The partnership with ONDC, a non-profit private organisation founded by the Indian government's Department for Pro-

motion of Industry and Internal Trade, is expected to advance Uber's objective of providing all Indians with dependable, safe, and reasonably priced rides. Khosrowshahi also discussed "Building Population Scale Technology" with Infosys Chairman Nandan Nilekani at an event in Bengaluru. In Delhi, he met commerce minister Piyush Goyal as well as external affairs minister S Jaishankar on Friday. "Encouraging to hear the optimism of Uber CEO @dkhos on doing business in India. The world takes note of the transformation of the last decade. And awaits the coming opportunities. Good to know that he even tried his hand at cricket," Jaishankar said in a post on X on Friday. "Held a discussion with Dara Khosrowshahi, CEO of @Uber. Deliberated on the company's vision for India's growth & strengthening the partnership considering our unparalleled digital infrastructure," Goyal said in a separate post on his meeting on X on Friday. He also suggested comprehensive measures that are crucial and mandatory for directing free and fair elections. Later, the CEO also visited the Namchi Municipal Council to overlook the status and collection of form 12 for postal ballots. (IPR)

## Respective dists of Sikkim exchange Form 12 of Postal Ballot at State Level Exchange Centre

**PAKYONG, FEB 24 /--/** In line with the current electoral processes in Sikkim, the first batch of Form 12 postal ballots for all six districts (Gyalshing, Namchi, Gangtok, Soreng, Pakyong, and Mangan) of Category 1 (Presiding & Polling Officers) was carried out in compliance with the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) at the State Level Exchange Centre of Rangpo Tourist Facilitation Centre. The exchanged Form 12s are categorised into three distinct groups (Category 1: Presiding & Polling Personnel, Category 2: Police Department, Category 3: Others). Furthermore, it is essential for the districts to securely retain the acknowledgment slip, as it stands as the exclusive evidence of Form 12 exchange. The exchange was executed under the guidance of Anupa Tamling, ADC Pakyong cum Returning Officer Pakyong and ARO



Pakyong for Postal Ballot, along with all district Nodal Officers for Postal Ballot. During the exchange, the district-specific cartons containing the forms were handed over to their respective districts at the State Level Exchange Centre. The forms were thoroughly

checked and verified, and then handed over to the respective nodal officers for postal ballots of the concerned district. This methodical procedure is implemented to ensure transparency and precision in the electoral process. Additionally, an acknowledgment slip in format 3 was signed by

both the Assistant Returning Officer (ARO) issuing the bundle and the ARO receiving it. This slip holds significance as it acts as the sole proof of the Form 12 exchange, highlighting the meticulous attention to detail and adherence to protocol in the electoral operations. (IPR)

## Ram temple in Ayodhya receives donations of around Rs 25 cr

**AYODHYA, FEB 24 /--/** The newly constructed Ram temple has received donations, including 25 kg gold and silver ornament, of around Rs 25 crore in a month after the consecration ceremony on January 22, trust officials on Saturday said. Prakash Gupta, office in charge of the Ram temple trust, said the amount of Rs 25 crore include cheques, drafts and cash deposited in the temple trust's office along with those deposited in the

donation boxes. "However, we are not aware of the online transactions done directly in the trust's bank accounts," he added. Gupta said that a total of around 60 lakh devotees have had darshan since January 23. "The devotion of Ram devotees is such that they are donating items made of silver and gold for Ram Lalla which cannot be used in Shri Ram Janmabhoomi temple, despite this, considering the devotion of the devotees, Ram Mandir Trust is accepting jewellery, utensils and materials made of gold and silver," he said. Gupta said the temple trust is expecting an increase in donations during the days of Ram Navami festival

when about 50 lakh devotees will be present in Ayodhya. Gupta further said the State Bank of India (SBI) has installed four automatic high-tech counting machines at Ram Janmabhoomi to control the heavy inflow of cash and expected offering during the Ram Navami. "A dozen computerised counters have been made by the Trust to issue receipts and additional donation boxes are being kept at the temple premises by the Ram temple trust. Soon a big and well-equipped counting room will be constructed at Ram temple premises," he said. Anil Mishra, trustee of the Ram temple trust, said that for

the valuation of gold and silver jewellery and precious materials received as gift to Ram Lalla, their melting and maintenance has been handed over to the Government of India Mint. Mishra said along with this, an MoU has been signed between the SBI and the Trust. According to the MoU, the SBI will take full responsibility of collection of donations, offerings, cheques, drafts and cash and deposit it in the bank, he added. Mishra said that a team of the SBI started its work by increasing the staff and counting of donated cash is being done in two shifts daily. (PTI)

## Under 1 case per 10,000 population: India takes step towards kala azar elimination

**NEW DELHI, FEB 24 /--/** India has reported less than one case of visceral leishmaniasis (VL), commonly known as kala azar, per 10,000 population, and a major step towards eliminating the often fatal, parasitic disease, say official sources. The data from 2023, the first time it has reached the less than one figure across all blocks, has been recently communicated to the World Health Organization (WHO), the officials said.

A disease is considered eliminated when the number of reported cases is below 1 per 10,000 people in each of the country's blocks for at least three consecutive years. According to the National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme (NVBDCP), 520 cases and four deaths of kala azar were reported last year compared to 818 cases and three deaths in 2022. Around 595 people had HIV-VL co-infection in 2023 compared to 891 the previous year. "India has reported less than one case per 10,000 population across all blocks in 2023. It is a major step towards eliminating kala azar. We have intimated the WHO regarding the development," an official told PTI. Visceral leishmaniasis (VL) is caused by protozoan parasites transmitted by

the bite of an infected female phlebotomine sand fly. It is characterised by irregular bouts of fever, weight loss, enlargement of the spleen and liver, and anaemia. In over 95 per cent of cases, the disease is fatal if left untreated. The initial target year for the elimination of the disease in India was 2010. This was later extended to 2015, then 2017, and 2020. In October 2023, Bangladesh became the first country in the world to be officially validated by the WHO for eliminating kala azar as a public health problem.

Till now, kala azar was endemic in India in over 630 blocks mainly in four states — Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal and Uttar Pradesh. A few of these blocks reported over one case per 10,000 in the last decade resulting in India missing the elimination deadlines. Much of the success of India's fight against VL is attributed to the role of the anti-fungal drug liposomal amphotericin B manufactured by the US-based biopharmaceutical company Gilead Sciences. The company, through the WHO, had donated 4,45,000 doses free to the country. This was then adopted in the control programme in 2013. "The availability of a single infusion of liposomal amphotericin B proved to be the game changer that VL needed; it dramatically brought down the cases," Dr. Mitali Chatterjee, professor of Pharmacology at Kolkata's Institute of Postgraduate Medical Education & Research (IPGMER) told PTI in November. (PTI)

## 3-term TN Cong MLA joins BJP

**NEW DELHI / CHENNAI, FEB 24 /--/** S Vijayadharani, a Congress MLA from Tamil Nadu for three consecutive terms, joined the BJP on Saturday, asserting that the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi is very important for the country.

The development is a shot in the arm for the BJP in the southern state where it has struggled to gain ground. Vijayadharani is the MLA from Vilavancode, which is part of the Kanyakumari Lok Sabha seat, a constituency the BJP has won in the past. She posted on X her letter of resignation from the Congress before joining the BJP. She joined the party in the national capital in the presence of Union Minister L Murugan and the party's national secretary Arvind Menon, who is the poll in-charge for Tamil Nadu. Vijayadharani lauded the central government for its various good schemes and lamented that some of those are not being implemented in Tamil Nadu, where the DMK-Congress alliance is in power. A lot of great things are happening to the country, she said, praising the BJP's focus on women. Murugan said people from different sections of society are coming forward to join the BJP to strengthen Modi's hand. The BJP was unable to win any of the 39 Lok Sabha seats in Tamil Nadu in the 2019 general elections. Vijayadharani, who is also a successful lawyer, is the first sitting MLA to join the BJP. Prior to the 2021 Assembly election, former state Minister from the AIADMK Nainar Nagendra joined the saffron party from the southern district of Tirunelveli and he is currently the party floor leader. The Kanyakumari district from where she hails is represented by senior BJP leader M R Gandhi from Nagercoil in the Assembly House. She joins the increasing list of legislators from the district which sent C Velayutham Pillai from the Padmanabhapuram constituency to the Assembly for the first time in 1996. The political career of Vijayadharani, an intense debater in TV channels, spans over three decades and she is known for her sense of commitment to public service and a strong focus on welfare of the marginalised. "Her presence will be advantageous to the BJP as she has established for herself a clean image championing the cause of the people especially the downtrodden," a senior BJP leader said. He confirmed that she was in touch with the senior leaders in the party before taking the final plunge to embrace the BJP. Her conspicuous absence in the Assembly during the brief Budget session which concluded on February 22, raised eyebrows and sparked rumours of her joining the BJP. But, the new TNCC chief Selvaperunthagai denied that she was quitting the Congress. (PTI)
